

This is an *Unofficial Tabulation* of the Elections results. The Burnet County Elections Administrator will schedule the review of provisional ballots and determine whether they will be accepted or rejected. The provisional ballots will be returned to the Early Voting Ballot Board, who will then meet to count or not count (depending on the Burnet County Elections Administrator disposition) the ballots. The presiding judge of the early voting ballot board shall make a new return sheet of those votes.

The *Official Canvass* of the election will be conducted on May 17, 2016 at a Special meeting of the City Council of the City of Granite Shoals.
