



Residential: Electrical ~ Plumbing ~ Mechanical

Electrical Upgrades/Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required for all service upgrades or circuit replacements and repairs to electrical service.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

Plumbing Upgrades/ Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required when a gas line is added, replaced or repaired, installing gas logs inside your fireplace, replacing a gas or electric water heater, adding a water softener to your home or sprinkler system, sewer repair or replacement and minor plumbing renovations.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

Sprinkler Permits: An approved backflow device must be installed with each sprinkler system.

Mechanical Upgrades/ Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required when an air conditioner or furnace is replaced.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

Contractor Registration required for General, Electrician, Mechanical, Irrigator, and Backflow

Tester.

All Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical work described above require an inspection.
