

§ 2-169. Ethics review commission.

- (a) The city council shall appoint an ethics review commission consisting of three qualified voters from the City of Granite Shoals, who shall serve two year staggered terms from date of appointment.
- (b) The ethics review commission has jurisdiction over ethics complaints involving city officials.
- (c) The ethics review commission shall have the authority to review and investigate complaints filed in accordance with this article and issue a written finding of the commission's determination when appropriate.
- (d) Service on the ethics review commission does not preclude a member from filing a complaint with the commission. The commission member filing the complaint must recuse himself/herself from the commission procedure.
- (e) The ethics review commission makes recommendations to the city council regarding revisions and changes to this article.
- (f) The ethics review commission may seek any necessary assistance from the city council and city manager regarding financial support needed to carry out the commission's duties.
- (g) If warranted, the city attorney may be utilized to advise and assist the commission and take part in hearings.
