

City Manager Report

June 2024

I am pleased to present the City Manager's Report for the month of June 2024. In addition to the departmental reports regarding finance, fire, streets and parks, police and utilities, this report provides an overview of key activities, committees, projects, events, and updates Citywide.

Communications and Community Engagement

The City has begun sharing video introductions of each of our esteemed City Councilmembers on our social media channels. Councilmember Dr. Steve Hougen and Councilmember Catherine Bell were highlighted in the "Council Connections" this month!

These video introductions are posted biweekly on Wednesdays to the City Facebook Page and to the City website giving you a chance to learn more about the people working hard to serve our community.

Canine Distemper - Update

We've received reports of several recent positive tests for canine distemper in our area. This serious and highly contagious disease affects the respiratory, gastrointestinal, and nervous systems of dogs.

To tackle this issue swiftly, the Humane Society and the City organized a FREE drive-thru vaccine clinic on June 8th at Quarry Park, where over 250 dogs and cats



received vaccines. We're thrilled to announce a second free vaccination clinic will be held on June 27th from 9 AM to noon, also at Quarry Park.

To remind everyone, digital message board signs in both English and Spanish will be placed on 1431 earlier in the week. Please also keep a lookout for more information on the City's social media channels. Vaccines provided will include DAPPV for dogs, FCP for cats, and Rabies for both dogs and cats.

Let's keep our furry friends safe and healthy!

<u>Finance</u>

The City held our first Budget Workshop on Thursday, June 20, 2024, 5pm in the Council Chambers. Additional Budget Workshops will also be held in the City Council Chambers on July 16th, July 30th, August 6th, August 20th, and September 3rd, 2024.

Committees and Workgroups

Community Cat Advisory Committee: The Community Cat Advisory Committee (CCAC) meeting scheduled for Monday, June 17th was canceled due to lack of quorum. On May 21st, the CCAC completed a successful Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) effort with 14 total cats trapped, transported, and sterilized in partnership with Pet Pals. Another TNR is scheduled for June 27th. The next CCAC meeting will be held on July 15th.

Planning and Zoning Committee: The Planning and Zoning committee met on June 18th to discuss and review Chapter 40 in the Code of Ordinances, zoning map, and the Heritage Tree Proclamation. The next meeting will be held on July 16th.

Wildlife Committee: Wildlife Committee met on June 3rd. This group also has a workday scheduled for June 29th. The next meeting for the Wildlife Committee is scheduled for July 8th.

Board of Adjustments: The Board of Adjustments (BOA) does not have any meetings scheduled.

Airport Committee: Airport committee met on June 6, 2024 and discussed the recent installation of an informational kiosk at the airport which will be used to relay info to visiting pilots as well as upcoming events. This committee also discussed the success of the recently held Future Pilot Event, parking and lease agreement, and obtaining an updated survey of the airport property. The next meeting will be held on July 11th.

Parks Committee: The Parks Committee met on June 6, 2024 and discussed updates related to Timberhill Park, funds from fill area, the QR code pilot program for boat launches, Community Center workdays, and Pickleball courts and lighting. The next meeting is scheduled to be held on July 11th.

Parks


