

RESOLUTION No. 700

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE SHOALS TEXAS, ADOPTING THE FEMA APPROVED BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS MULTI-JURISDICTION HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND APPOINTING THE MAYOR AS THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO ACT IN ALL MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR PORTION OF THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Shoals recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Shoals has participated in the Burnet County Hazard Mitigation Plan which is in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Burnet County Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Granite Shoals from impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Council demonstrates our commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Burnet County Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this plan will make City of Granite Shoals eligible to apply for current and future Hazard Mitigation Grants; and


WHEREAS, Hazard Mitigation Action Plans are required to appoint an official to act as the Authorized Representative in all matters in connection with their portion of Burnet County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF GRANITE SHOALS:


